Peace Open "Amici sumus"

We stand by the Ukrainian people and strongly condemn the Russian war of aggression against Ukraine.

The aim of the tournament is the friendship and respect of all players of the ICCF who want to stand in solidarity with Ukraine and set an example in this way.

Any player, including Russian and Belarusian players who stand in solidarity with Ukraine. can participate in this tournament, regardless of his rating.

This tournament is organized on the initiative of the BDF and the ICCF.

There are no prizes. The entry fees will be donated to a non-profit organization to help the people of Ukraine and/or refugees from that country.

Tournament Organization

Start date 01.05.2022

Entry deadline 15.4.2022

No end date for the tournament

The tournament will be played in a single phase.

Registrations

- Registration via direct entry
- Entry fees/ per participation 9,36 €; multiple entries are possible

The tournament will be rated by ICCF and valid to get norms for the ICCF titles in the groups with category 1 or higher that meet all the conditions required by the ICCF.

Playing system

ICCF standard time control 10 moves in 50 days with duplication after 20 days is used.

Registered players will be sorted by rating order. The first 11 to 15 players form the first group, the following 11 to 15 players form the second group and so on.

The groups are formed with players of as similar a rating as possible. The number of groups depends on the number of registrations.

Member Federations are asked to give the tournament wide publicity to all their players.
